A Poet's Stories: A Perspective on Cahit Sıtkı Tarancı's Stories

Abstract: Cahit Sttki Taranci, one of the well-known names of Turkish poetry in Republican period, wrote more individual poems in the distressed environment of World War II. Taking themes such as loneliness, death, love, poverty as problems of ordinary people, Taranci reminds more of the sensitivity of the Garip poem, which represents poetry concept of the same age in terms of the themes he works in his poems. Although Cahit Sttki Taranci is known for his poetry, he wrote also stories. His stories in the newspapers and magazines have been published as a book some time ago. But there are still stories that have not entered their books. In "A Poet's Stories: Cahit Sttki Taranci's The Perspective Problem", focuses on the image of the themes of his poetry which covered in the story. Because Cahit Sttki Taranci also discusses many of the topics that the poetry art deals with in the framework of the rules, at the same time in his stories. The technical difference between the poem and the story causes the themes and topics covered to be handled differently in both arts. That is why the possibilities of story art are more than the art of poetry. At the same time, the presantation reveals the connection between Cahit Sttki's world of emotion & thought and the conditions of the age.

Examination of the Learning Approaches Used by Prospective Teachers

Abstract: The aim of the study is to determine the learning approaches used by prospective teachers and to examine whether they differ in terms of several variables or not. To this end, answers for the following questions are sought: 1. To what extent do prospective teachers use deep and surface learning approaches? 2. Do the learning approaches used by prospective teachers differ in terms of gender, age and department variables? Quantitative research method was employed in the study. The population of the study, carried out in survey design, consisted of prospective teachers attending a teacher training certificate programme at a university in Turkey in 2014-2015 academic year. The sampling of the study was 344 teacher candidates in the departments of "Turkish Language and Literature", "History", Philosophy", "Geography" and "Religious Culture". "Revised Two Factor Study Process Questionnaire (R-SPQ-2F)" adapted to Turkish by Önder and Beşoluk (2010) was used as the means of data collection. The questionnaire consists of 20 five point likert items and two subcategories. The data were analysed in SPSS 22,0 statistics package programme. Percentage, frequency, mean, standard deviation, independent samples t-test and one-way Anova were used to analyse the data. According to the results of the study, prospective teachers use deep learning approaches more than surface learning approaches. Although prospective teachers' use of deep learning approaches don't differ with respect to gender, their use of surface learning approaches differ in favour of male prospective teachers. It was also found out in the study that age variable doesn't have an influence on the learning approaches of prospective teachers. Surface learning approaches differ in terms of department variable.
